REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

Please provide original and certified copies of the required documents. Documents that are issued in languages other than English must be accompanied with an official English translation.

1. Valid Passport for the period of your stay in the Republic of South Sudan,
2. Recent two (2) original and clear coloured passport size photographs,
3. Copy of passport, Temporary permit accompanied by a copy of National ID card,
4. If you are employed: A letter from your employer stating your purpose of visit to the Republic of South Sudan, plus company identity card,
5. If you intend to visit business/organization or the Republic of South Sudan provide a letter of invitation,
6. For business people: Details of your business appointments, business intentions and License,
7. Copy of yellow fever card/vaccination.

PERMIT FEE:

Please note: that all payments are to be deposited in the bank. The Embassy will only receive applications with a bank receipt attached. Any entry/travel permit application form submitted without attachment of bank receipt will straight away be revoked and the person will not be allowed to travel to the Republic of South Sudan then and in future.

Multiple Visas is for only.

- 1) Diplomats.
- 2) International Non Government Organizations (NGOS).
- 3) Church Missions.

Single Visas

- 1) Single Visas application is for everyone.
